

COMMUNITY ORCHARDS IN FRODSHAM

In 2012 sixty apple trees were donated by Frodsham Town Council and planted by the local community in Churchfield and Hawthorne Road Area, under the leadership of Frodsham Transition Initiative (FTI), to commemorate the Queen's 60th Jubilee. Later on, further trees were donated and planted by Cheshire Landscape Trust and FTI.

FTI's aim is to encourage communities to work together and to become self-sufficient.

In 2013, thirty fruit trees consisting of pear; plum; gage; damson and apple, bought using money kindly donated by Frodsham Town Council, were planted in Hob Hey Wood by volunteers including Scouts.

This year FTI intend to plant 30 more fruit trees in Hob Hey Wood.
