- Martin has been in touch with Cheshire Wildlife Trust about running a Forest School taster. There may be a charge, but he will see if there is any possibility of it being provided for free.
- The tenant of the heavy anti-aircraft gunsite in Sutton Weaver ahs animals on the land and is not willing to provide access for a VE Day walk.
