### Townfield Lane Consultation – Responses Summary - April 2017

The following is a summary of comments from responses to FTC re the above:

#### **Townfield Lane Play Area**

- Safe to walk to – no need to cross roads – encourages independence
- Encourages children away from computers to play/exercise outside
- Ease of use for local estates
- In constant use, especially after school and during holidays
- Free from litter
- No cars
- No dogs
- No dog dirt
- Hours spent watching grandchildren playing safely
- Future mums and nans
- Enjoyable outdoor area for Link Club and Holiday Club (Manor House School)
- Used many times to meet up with other parents and children
- Picnics
- Organised play by groups of parents
- Needs only basic equipment, so low cost
- One resident has offered contribution of £1000 to help maintain/update equipment
- Elderly residents walk to there, and rest on benches
- Green open spaces essential part of keeping healthy
- Ready access for people who have physical ailments, or difficulty walking/pushing prams, or in wheelchair
- Not just about cost, but value
- Allows children to ‘build memories of happy adventures’
- Very precious to local residents
- Posters supporting retaining the park ‘in 30 windows’ on Lakes estate
- Very much valued
- Lovely neighbourhood feel
- Fear of loss of income to the school
- One youngster would like space converted to mountain biking area

#### **Community Centre comments**

- Moving to community centre field would limit access for children and residents from east of Fluin Lane, due to busy road
- Community centre field catchment already have Churchfield Play Area
- Might cost more to put crossing on Fluin Lane?
