Townfield Lane Play Area Consultation

Frodsham residents were consulted throughout March on three options for the future of Townfield Road Play Area.

A whole page of Frodsham Life was devoted to the consultation, with an online voting option through the FTC website. The consultation was promoted several times through the month on the Council's Facebook and Twitter social media accounts. An action group of local residents, concerned that some people had not received a copy of Frodsham Life, or had overlooked the consultation, canvassed door to door, using reprints of the relevant page from Frodsham Life.

Overall, 980 responses were received, comprised of 669 online votes and 312 paper votes.


The votes were filtered initially to ensure that only votes from Frodsham electors were counted¹, and to eliminate likely duplicate votes or those with no valid postcode².

The overall count of accepted votes was:

The percentage split of the raw votes and the accepted vote counted was identical.

The largest vote was from the Lakes ward, where the play area is situated, but all four wards participated in the voting.
