Since 2011 the project has raised awareness of the rare neuromuscular conditions known as centronuclear and myotubular myopathy by growing sunflowers.

The 2018 project has been donated a large number of dwarf sunflower seeds, most of which I am unlikely to use, so I am writing to see if you might have any use for these in your community, maybe you have an area of land that needs brightening up or a school, nursery, brownies or scouts, a youth group or community group that would enjoy growing them.

I would be happy for the seeds to go to one organisation or to share the seeds between many. There would be no charge for the seeds, all I ask is that you would be able to collect the seeds from me in Chester and share some photos which would be posted online to raise awareness of the project.
