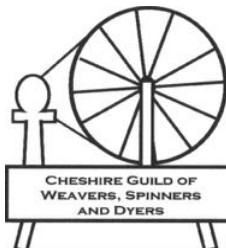
And we welcome back **Crab Apple Crafters** who will be paper crafting and scrapbooking on the third Friday of each month from 10am - 4.00pm.
