Commemorative Tree Policy

- Objective** To provide trees in memory of a person or to celebrate an anniversary or other special event
- Scope** This policy covers the planting of trees by FTC on their land or any public open space with the governing authority's permission, and the adoption of trees in such public places
- Eligibility** Any resident of Frodsham can apply to subscribe for a commemorative tree. FTC may, from time to time, plant or adopt a tree in memory of a past Frodsham Councillor or other special occasion.
- Availability** At the present time there are few places to plant a new tree. There is a much better chance of being selected to proceed with a commemorative tree if the subscriber chooses to adopt an existing tree.
- Choice** A member of the Environment Committee will advise in choosing a tree species and location. The final decision rests with FTC. For adoption, the office has a record of available trees.
- Planting** By prior arrangement, it may be possible to attend the planting of a new tree. The tree will be planted by the Environment Committee or its contractor.
- Record** An A4 form for recording the planting or adoption of a tree and the reason for doing so is required. This leads to a page being entered in the Commemorative Tree Book. While a standard page is available, the applicant may produce their own design if they wish.
- Cost** There is no charge.
