## A fantastic £8,000 has been raised

The two primary charities – *St Laurence's Parish Church* and *Frodsham Community Association* were chosen because they are important hubs for the whole community, providing opportunities for people of all ages to meet and share in all kinds of activities. They also host and support many fund raising events throughout the year. Funds are also being allocated towards the refurbishment of the *War Memorial* in the churchyard and the *Parish Hall*.

The Junior Mayors have chosen to support two national cancer charities *Against Breast Cancer* and *Teenage Cancer Trust*
