# Notes of Meeting held on Friday 23 February 2018

#### 1. Notes of last meeting

The notes of the Working Group meeting held on 8 February 2018 were accepted as an accurate record of the meeting.

### 2. Car Sharing

It was agreed to include a general car sharing message in the leaflet but not to mark up specific walks as suitable for car sharing.

#### 3. Walks leaflet

The working group reviewed the text sent to the printers and a number of amendments agreed. The Admin Officer was asked to contact walk leaders whose descriptions had been changed substantively as a matter of courtesy to check that they were happy with the revised text; to check with the leaders of walks 10 & 12 whether they would like us to add the byline "Supported by North and Mid Cheshire Ramblers"; and to make it clear in Walk 22 that the coach would leave Anderton at 4.30pm.

Liz reported that she had spoken to The Red Bull in Kingsley and confirmed the arrangements with them. She has also spoken to Anne Shaw, who was happy with the contingency arrangements for the Pub Walk.

The final approval of the printer's proofs of the leaflet and poster were delegated to a sub-group comprising of Cllr Caroline Ashton, Sue Kellett and Liz Kenny, who will meet for the purpose on Wednesday 28 February at 9.30am. Hawk Media (the printers) confirmed that sign-off of the proofs on 28 February would still enable printing and deliver by the end of the week commencing 5 March.
