What is the percentage of public green space within the Frodsham Parish and how does this compare with other Parishes in CWAC area.	13/03/2018	13/02/2018	FTC is considering selling a plot of land that has stood empty for approximately 15 years. The proximity of the extensive open space at Saltworks including skate park and children's play area was an important factor in the original decision not to replace the unsafe equipment at the time. I suggest you speak to Lord Frank Pennington to get more of the history. The only cost to FTC, at the moment, is the mowing of the area, which wasn't done last year. There were some minor repairs to the fencing carried out by our Facilities Manager too. There would, of course, be a significant cost to developing it for other uses. The Neighbourhood Plan people could probably tell you about the amount of green space. Active Cheshire may be able to say how that compares to the other parishes.
