

Fed up with roads or footpaths you use?

Is your journey to work, your local school, shops, bus stop or station made unsafe or more difficult by the condition of a footpath or road, due to say a pothole, manhole cover, overgrown hedge, obstruction or another fault?





If so, **YOU** can let the Cheshire West & Chester Council know **DIRECTLY** & quite easily and the CWAC Highways Department will quickly check it out. In case you are wondering, CWAC have just had an **extra £3.5m** to help them do just this.

What you can do. Go to https://cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/residents/residents.aspx

Select the tab 'Report a Highways Fault' and then, follow the link to 'Report a new Fault', add in the details & ideally a photo. You will then receive a trackable acknowledgement.

Our experience within the Cycle North Cheshire team is that, you will **not be wasting your time**, as bad potholes (4 cm or more) are usually repaired within a few weeks. However, if a pothole has a white line round it then CWAC already know about it and plan to repair it. Reported major repairs such as resurfacing work takes longer but some have been repaired.

If you want to help make life safer & easier for yourself and your family in their daily lives, please try this out, as it will also help make life better for everyone.
