The Secretary of State gives notice of the proposal to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of two part-widths of Main Street, adjacent to The Cheshire Cheese public house site, at Frodsham in Cheshire West and Chester.

If made, the Order would authorise the stopping up only to enable development as permitted by Cheshire West and Chester Council under reference 19/04085/FUL.

They will also be available for inspection during normal opening hours at Frodsham Council, Castle Park, Frodsham WA6 6SB during those 28 days.
